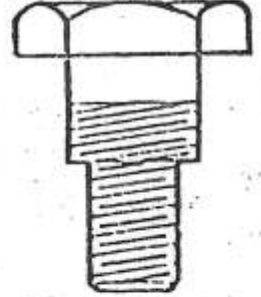
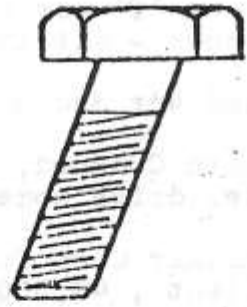
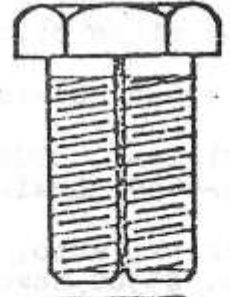


For mismatched bolt holes.

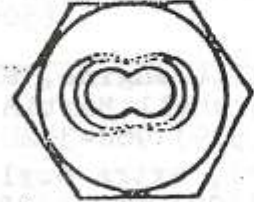
For holes too near the edge

For holes drilled crooked and then straightened up (nut is hard starting)



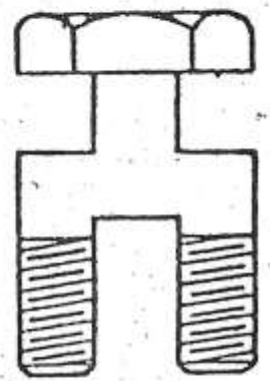
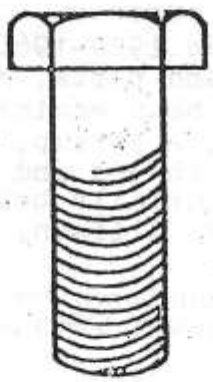
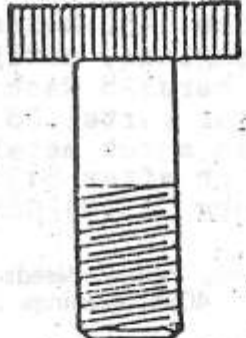
For holes with countersink on the wrong side

Binocular bolt, for double-drilled holes

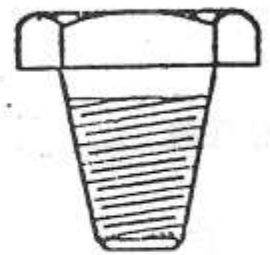
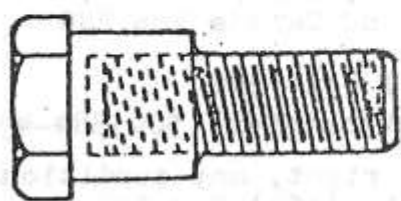


For double counter sunk holes

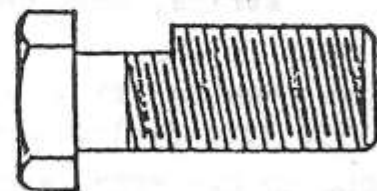
Serrated head for vice-grip torquing
