FOOD FOR THOUGHT

1. How long is an engine hour? (What is it?)

4. Is the turbo charger turbine wheel faster than superman at 120,000 rpms with a compressor wheel 4.5" in diameter? (superman is faster than a streaking bullit 30-06 180gr) or faster than the concord flying at 2.2 speed of sound at 30,000 ft. in the air?
